Since 1953, the Legislative Council Staff (LCS) has served as the nonpartisan research arm of the Colorado General Assembly. The staff serve under the Director of Research and provide support to legislative committees, respond to requests for research and constituent services, prepare fiscal notes, provide revenue projections, and perform other centralized legislative support services such as Information Technology, Visitor Services, and more.

LCS uses social media to share timely updates about the work of the Legislative Council Staff, advertise job opportunities, provide educational information about the Capitol, promote staff-led events like the Colorado Day celebration, appreciate its staff and volunteers, and provide general Capitol building updates. Each post is written and reviewed to ensure alignment with the LCS mission, vision, and values statement, and that the post is factual, objective, and nonpartisan.
