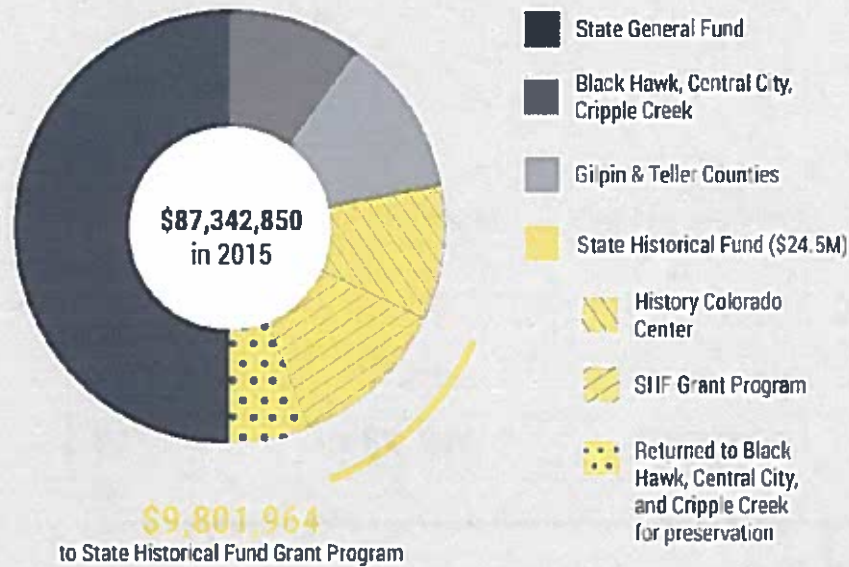

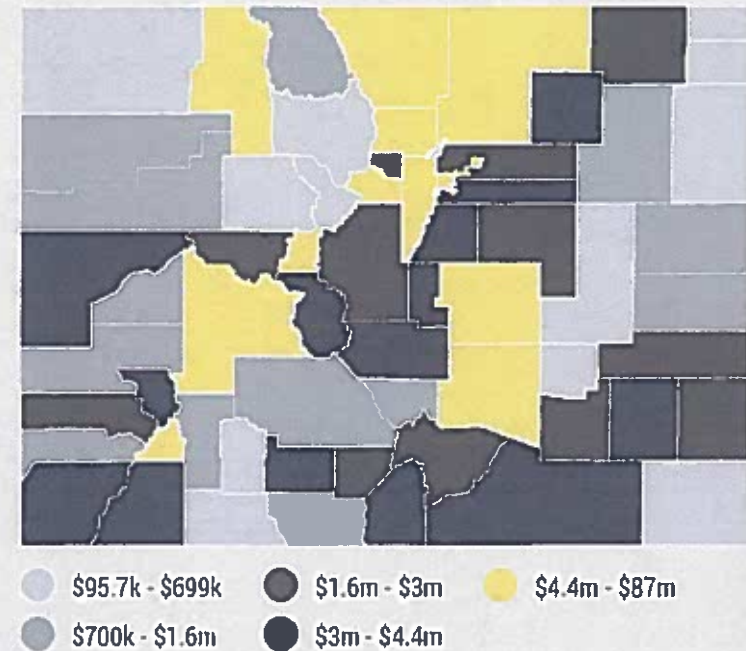

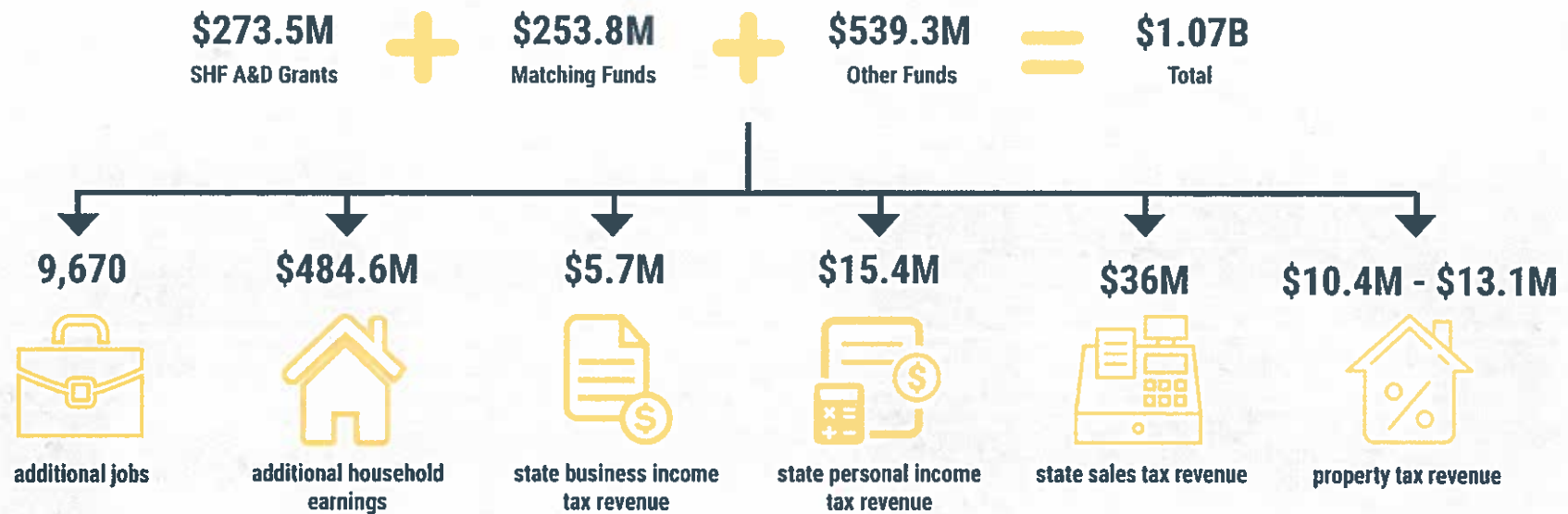
Distribution of State Gaming Revenue, 2015

State Historical Fund Direct Economic Impacts, 1993-2015 (\$ adjusted for inflation)



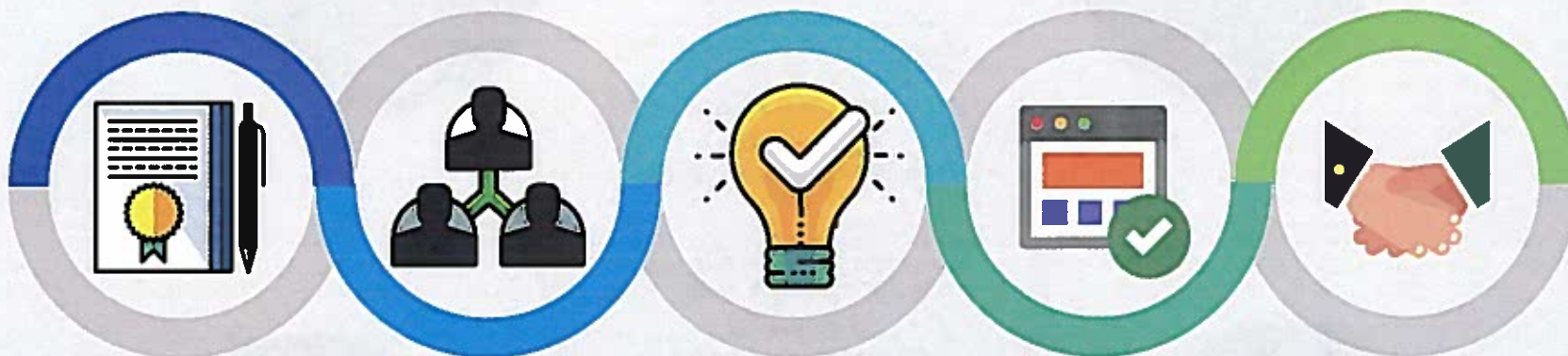

- 4200 projects funded
- Grants in all 64 counties
- \$286 million awarded

Application Submission

- Drafts welcome anytime
- Competitive Application
- Deadlines: April 1 and October 1


