








Distribution of State Gaming Revenue, 2015




State Historical Fund Grants by County, 1993-2015






State Historical Fund Direct Economic Impacts, 1993-2015 (\$ adjusted for inflation)

Efforts to provide information to the public about historic sites or preservation

Historic Structure Assessments

Determination of the preservation needs and priorities of a building/site.

*With justification up to \$5,000 can be included for necessary consultant and up to \$5,000 for a feasibility study
